

PROMOTION CRITERIA

A minimum of 80% attendance is a must for appearing in the annual examination. A minimum of 40% or “D” grade in each subject is a must for promotion to the next class.

Appearance in examination and evaluation tests is compulsory. **Application / medical certificate by the parent within three days is a must for missing a test for any untoward happening / on medical grounds.** No separate tests are held in such cases. Promotion is given on the basis of aggregate of the remaining exams / previous tests. Absence from examination / tests for any other reasons is not condoned.

Pre-school

No formal examination is held. Promotion is granted on the basis of attendance, continuous assessments and observational activities. A comprehensive report is issued thrice first term, middle term, and annual term.

Performance Indicators of Pre- School are:

A- Confident - Outstanding creative expressions and understanding.

B - Able to do - Takes interest in all class activities, completes work timely and neatly, has clear concepts.

C - Needs Support - Effort is required to come up to the appropriate level; needs help to complete work.

Guidelines for parents: Achievements record is meant to keep you informed about the progress of your ward. Evaluation is done on the basis of periodic tests, notebook submission and subject enrichment activities.

Information about the performance of your ward in co-curricular activities, Discipline and Attendance is also given.

Performance Indicators (Pre-Primary -V)

A - (80-100) Confident: Exhibits outstanding creative expression in all activities. Works independently with enthusiasm and understanding. Shows a lot of initiative and conscientious effort. Takes lead in group exercise.

B - (50-79) Able to do : Exhibits responsibility and eagerness to work in all class activities; Completes work timely and neatly; Has clear concepts and reasoning ability; is cooperative in group exercise.

C - (41-49) Below Average : Lacks initiative and responsibility; Gets distracted easily; A lot of efforts is required to come up to the appropriate performance level; Needs help to complete work.

D - (33-40) Needs Support : Performance has been lower than desired standards; overall improvement in academic grades is required.

E - (32 and Below) Needs Improvement : Child has to reappear in exam or will be failed.

Pass Criteria for XI and XII

A candidate will be eligible to get the pass certificate if he / she gets a grade higher than E or 33% in all subjects. In case of a subject involving practical work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in practical separately in addition to 33% marks in theory in order to qualify in that subject.
